

Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP)



What is HPRP?

- A new program being offered to persons who are homeless or on the verge of becoming homeless.
- A new program to provide *temporary financial assistance* to help persons gain housing stability.

What are some of the program requirements?

- Applicants must live in Black Hawk, Buchanan, or Grundy County at the time of application.
- Applicants must have a household income below 50% of the area median income.
- Applicants must agree to meet regularly with a case manager.
- Applicants receiving rental assistance must have the rental unit meet specified inspection.
