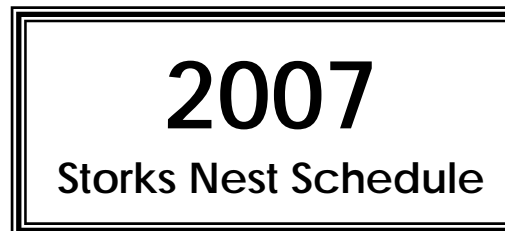

Stork's Nest Educational Opportunities

The following classes are held on **Wednesdays from 10:00 to 11:00 am** at the Waterloo YWCA, 425 Lafayette Street

Participants **earn 25 points** for each class attended when they are *signed in and seated* by 10:10 a.m. The Stork's Nest Coordinator updates point ledger cards during class.

Classes are offered in educational series. **Series bonus points** are awarded at the end of each month of classes. An additional **50 points** are earned when all classes are attended in a month. If only one absence occurs during the month an additional **25 points** are earned.
