Operation Threshold & The Cedar Valley Key Card Program

How Does A Key Card Work?

The Cedar Valley Key Card Program open doors to recreational and cultural events for limited income individuals and families. A Key Card allows reduced cost or free admission for some community programs in the area.

Eligible family members receive a Key Card I.D. through Operation Threshold. Each family is issued a Key Card at no cost. The Key Card is valid for two years from the date received. Card replacement fee is \$1.00. Key Cards will be issued to an adult household member. The eligible children's names and birth dates will be listed on the back of the adult I.D.

How To Apply For A Key Card?

Households who are LIHEAP (Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program) approved or receiving WIC will be automatically eligible for a Key Card. Households receiving FIP, SSI, Food Stamps, or Medicaid (Title 19) will need to provide proof of assistance (current award letter, copy of food stamp/EBT card, or copy of Medicaid card). Households who are not receiving assistance from any of these programs should call Operation Threshold at (319) 291-2065 and schedule an appointment. An intake worker will need to verify all household income to determine eligibility.

How Do I Find Out About Eligible Key Card Programs?

Due to the types of programs involved, some may have limited availability, meaning there may be a limited amount of seating or space available. Information on individual programs can be obtained by contacting the individual program listed below.
